### **WVMHA Extra Practice Policy**

November 10, 2005

It has been brought to the attention of the Executive of the W.V.M.H.A. that players have been practicing out of their respective groups. While it was felt that there are times when this is appropriate, the executive felt that some restraints must be put on these occurrences.

As a result, for the remainder of the year no individual player may practice outside of the group they have registered for with the W.V.M.H.A. unless the following criteria have been met: 1) A written request must be made to and approved by the Board of the W.V.M.H.A. stating the reason why this player should be allowed to practice with another group. The benefit they will get and the benefit to our association.

2) Written approval from the coach in the group to which that player will be attending the additional practices.

Once approval has been attained from the Board and the coach, the player will be notified of the dates for these additional practices. The Board will only provide approval for a maximum of three weeks or six practices. Each player is allowed to apply for additional practices once each season. This policy is subject to space availability. And it applies to coaches children who are on the ice while their siblings are practicing in their respective groups.

This policy is subject to annual review by the Board of the W.V.M.H.A.
